Welcome and Review

Peggy provided a quick recap of the January 11th conference call. This call primarily focused on a game plan to encourage labs to participate in the workgroup calls and consider harmonizing and standardizing radon data.

Encouraging Labs to Harmonizing Data

The workgroup agreed that we need to get a better handle of what “what’s in it for labs” and “how will this effort help their business” before inviting them to the table. A meeting with the labs will fail if we don’t have a solid agenda and have a specific request for the labs.

The following is the game plan to encourage labs to participate in workgroup conference calls:

- Send invitation to labs to participate in a demonstration of the CDC’s Environmental Public Health Tracking Network (EPHTN) and state specific information (CO and NJ). Demo is tentatively scheduled for March 7th.
- Overview of importance of harmonizing and standardizing data pushed into CDC’s National Repository.
- Solicit interest in labs who may want to push data into the National Repository once pilot is completed.

- Set up practice session for the demo for CDC, CO and NJ.
- Send invitation with conference call and webinar information to labs and workgroup members.
